

Marshall Plan Against Poverty - introduced in 2016

- Subsistence Allowance to some 11,000 low income families
- 2. Assistance to **students** from vulnerable backgrounds
- 3. Training and empowerment for women
- 4. Social Housing Programme
- 5. Improved access to potable water
- 6. Inclusive Innovation Families on the SRM have free access to Broadband Internet



Bold Educational Reforms

- Free primary, secondary and tertiary education in public institutions
- Promotion of inclusive education:
 - ✓ Polytechnics
 - √ Special Education Needs
 - √ Fortified Learning Environment
 - √ Extended Programme for specialised and focused support

In 2018, 20.7% of our energy mix was from RE. We aim to reach 35% by 2025.






Building Partnerships


- Whole-of-society approach to policy making
