Additional Information	The 2002 NSSD of Greece is currently being reformed in the light of recent administrative changes and new political priorities set in Greece. The reformulated NSSD encompasses the same priorities (7 challenges and 2 cross cutting issues) as the Renewed EU Strategy for S.D. (2006) plus four additional priorities of national interest, i.e. Culture, Tourism, Agriculture and Physical Planning. Most importantly, following the recent Parliamentary Election (Oct 2009) and the establishment of a new "Ministry of Environment, Energy and Climate Change", political priorities for Greece, throughout the whole Governmental structure, have been set under the overarching objective of "Green Development". At the moment, the 2002 NSSD is being reformed so as to reflect not only the objectives of the reviewed 2006 EUSSD as well as new challenges and emerging approaches (e.g. efforts towards climate change mitigation and adaptation) at the international, regional and national level but also our new Ministry's vision, aims, competencies, tasks and structure as well as Greece's current overarching political strategic objective of "Green Development".
