


Proportion of population using different types of drinking water services, 2015 (percentage)







Proportion of population using different types of sanitation services, 2015 (percentage)




A majority of the world's population still lack safe sanitation and 892 Million people continue practise open

defecation




Conflict, violence and instability are curtailing progress on water and sanitation

Level of water stress: freshwater withdrawal as a proportion of available freshwater sources, around 2014 (percentage)




25%: Threshold that marks the beginning stages of water stress
