Mr Neymour has also served as Director of Procurement in the Organization of American States (OAS) and as The Bahamas Representative on the United Nations Committee for Budget Programming and Coordination amongst others. Mr. Neymour has been Senior Economic Advisor to several Prime Ministers of The Bahamas, and other Ministers with related portfolios including Trade, Economic Development and Financial Services.
