H.E. Mr. Gastón Lasarte is Ambassador and Director of Multilateral Affairs in the Ministry of External Affairs. He joined the Foreign Service in 1978 on merit as Third Secretary. Since then, Mr. Lasarte has occupied various positions including as Second Secretary in the Department of International Organizations, Director General of Political Affairs, Chief of Cabinet, Secretary General and Director General of Economic Affairs in the Ministry of External Relations, and Deputy Director of the Strategic Planning Division. He has also been First Secretary in the Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations in New York, Counsellor to the Head of the Secretary General of External Relations Office, and Chargé d'Affaires of Uruguay in Trinidad & Tobago as Minister Counsellor with concurrent accreditation to Antigua & Barbuda, Barbados, Jamaica, Grenada, St. Lucia, St. Vincent & the Grenadines, St. Kitts & Nevis.
