Crowdsourcing proposals for post-2015 to feed into the Intergovernmental Process on SDGs



Objectives

- To provide stakeholders with a platform to outline and disseminate their visions for new universal goals for sustainable development
- To help stakeholders become better informed about the wide range of proposals, expectations and evidence-based arguments on SDGs and other global goals
- To provide a mechanism for stakeholders to feed into the intergovernmental process on SDGs
- To increase the likelihood of an eventual SDGs framework which fully integrates the three dimensions of sustainable development



- Map existing proposals for global goals
- Enable stakeholders to submit their own recommendations. This includes both:
 - Proposals for specific goals, targets and indicators
 - Proposals for the principles and themes that the new framework should be based upon and address
- Provide an interactive platform to allow stakeholders to update their submissions and give feedback on other proposals.



Analysis and Advocacy

- Regular analysis of submissions will be undertaken to identify trends, commonalities and knowledge gaps
- This analysis will disseminated amongst stakeholders and used to inform the intergovernmental process on SDGs, via stakeholder engagement channels for the Open Working Group
- Users of the tool will be able to conduct their own analysis and identify areas of mutual interest


