

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PROJECT BACKGROUND

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2. The Role of INDONESIA WATER PARTNERSHIP (KAI)

■ Function :

- facilitator and provides a platform for multi stakeholder dialogue and consultation.
- support the process of Project implementation by giving advice at appropriate level, providing guiding documents and documented experiences and by coordinating the sharing of knowledge and findings.
- pre-financed most activities implemented

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3. Outputs

- Multi stakeholders commitment developed during December 2004 and February 2005 meetings;
- Government commitment stated in the letter of the Secretary General of the Ministry of Public Works of 21 June 2006 and given in meetings by the Minister of Public Works and other officials ;
- Verdict given by Constitutional Court in July 2005 confirming constitutional status of the new Water Resources Law ;
- Government statement given by the President and 11 Ministers in August 2005 to start a National Movement on Water Conservation;

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- More people get involved in water conservation :


Introduction and dissemination of simple technique on water conservation (Biophori)
