2 Foundation Principles



Functions, Responsibilities and Powers of Local Democratic Organs

- Efficient management and sustainable development of their areas and to give leadership by example. (action and development oriented)
- Create the environment and establish facilities to enable political, economic, social, environmental and cultural life of the people.
- Private/ Public parthnerships that encourages economic activities, stimulating production, promoting increasingly higher levels of efficiency, maintaining and preserving public prosperity, protecting communities from criminals, vandals and other anti-social activities. Raising cultural standards and levels of civic consciousness

• Generally safeguarding and improving their legal and other rights.

- Education and training drives
- Involvement of youth in local governance.
