

- To identify the significance and role of an Urban Local Body (ULB) in their own city, the main source of current income for the ULB, the mechanisms and approaches for optimizing local revenues, and the different mechanisms under which the ULB can raise money for financing urban infrastructure in the city;
- To apply decision making tools (Cost Benefit Analysis (CBA) and Multi Criteria Analysis (MCA) at different levels of decision making in financing urban infrastructure projects;
- To apply and implement all the lessons learned during the MOOC into the context of their own city/country respectively

The MOOC is based on 5 Modules and 5 weeks during which participants will learn:

WEEK 1: Introduction to urban finance

WEEK 2 : Financing Current expenditures

WEEK 3 : Financing Capital expenditures (CAPEX)

WEEK 4: Financial decision making for Municipal governments

WEEK 5: Capstone project








VIII. THE MOOC CERTIFICATE
