ROUNDTABLE WITH PACIFIC WOMEN: ADDRESSING SIDS ISSUES FROM LOCAL TO GLOBAL

This Roundtable will explore the gendered, cultural, social, economic and environmental dimensions of food security and sovereignty, agriculture and fisheries, environmental sustainability and climate justice.
