Excellency,

We would like to thank you for your constructive engagement in the consultations on the Ministerial Declaration of the high-level segment of the 2021 session of the Economic and Social Council and the high-level political forum on sustainable development, convened under the auspices of the Council.

Based on your comments, we are pleased to share with you the third revised draft of the Declaration.

In line with the announced timeline, we are inviting you to the fourth round of consultations that will take place as follows:

Thursday, 24 June 2021 from 10:00 am to 01:00 pm and from 03:00 pm to 06:00 pm.

We will also kindly ask you to send us all your written comments by the end of business on 24 June 2021. Please note that at this stage we understand that all delegations have had ample chance to submit their proposals, therefore we are not expecting any new substantial text proposals that contain new elements than those submitted earlier.

We encourage delegations to come to the upcoming round of informal consultations with the spirit of compromises and to limit their proposals to the minimum level possible, and emphasize in their interventions compromise and balanced proposals and amendments. We then intend to put the final text for silence procedure on 30th June 2021.

We rely on your support and cooperation in working together in a cooperative and inclusive manner to achieve an ambitious outcome of the 2021 ECOSOC session and the 2021 HLPF, with a focus on recovering better in the Decade of Action and Delivery.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of our highest consideration.
