It gives me great pleasure to share the integrated programme of the 2014 high level political forum on sustainable development under the auspices of ECOSOC, and the high level segment of ECOSOC containing the Ministerial Segment of HLPF, the Annual Ministerial Review and the Development Cooperation Forum, taking place from 30 June to 11 July 2014.

I shared with you an earlier draft of the programme on 8 May and also organized an informal briefing on the preparations for the programme on 14 May 2014. I am deeply grateful for your feedback and suggestions at the briefing. I have also coordinated with the members of the ECOSOC Bureau as well as with the President of the General Assembly, and the Bureaux of the Second and Third Committees and the major groups, in organizing the activities of the forum; and have had a series of consultations with member States. I would like to thank you for your efforts in encouraging high-level participation from your governments, which is befitting for the high level week.
