



What is SCP?







The creation and use of services and related products, which respond to basic needs and bring a better quality of life while minimising the use of natural resources and toxic materials as well as the emissions of waste and pollutants over the life cycle of the service or product so as not to jeopardise the needs of future generation



Demystifying SCP







The creation and use of services and related products, which respond to **basic needs** and bring a **better quality of life** while **minimising the use of natural resources** and toxic materials as well as the emissions of waste and pollutants <u>over</u> **the life cycle** of the service or product so as not to jeopardise the needs of future generation







Sustainable Buildings and Climate Initiative (SBCI): *Promote sustainable building policies and practices worldwide.*





GI-REC comprehensive review the first step of a long term process




• Comprehensive review - setting the foundation for future activities, ensuring that we have considered different perspectives in our approach
