- Updating existing partnerships to reflect the interrelated nature of the new Post 2015
- Targeting groups of countries or regions with similar challenges eg SIDS
- A MSP guide or information tool provided as part of the communication package for the Post 2015 agenda
- Addressing the silo approach from the beginning of new MSP

- Live meetings and conferences
- Dedicated follow up and review mechanism/framework for these partnerships
