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

# ECONOMIC KPIs (2013/14 – 2030)



Goal (8.1) Sustain per capita economic growth in accordance with national circumstances, and in particular at least 7% per annum GDP growth in the leastdeveloped countries

> Goal (8.6) by 2020 substantially reduce the proportion of youth not in employment, education or training

## **ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS**


An efficient and effective government administrative body, characterized by professionalism, transparency, justice and responsiveness, offers quality services, and can be held accountable, able to increase citizen satisfaction, and strongly contributes in the achievement of Egypt's development goals and in improving the status of the Egyptian people.

#### New Civil Service Law

Vision

- To improve the working conditions of civil employees and enhance transparency of government services and strengthen citizens' confidence in the state administration
  - Improve working conditions and income for civil employees
  - A New wage system
  - Effective, neutral and accurate evaluation system
  - An early retirement system
  - A new Code of conduct

## **ENERGY REFORM MEASURES**



• The government put in place measures to rationalize all subsidies during 2014/15 as part of a gradual plan in the medium term to reduce these subsidies.

• The government issued the renewables feed in tariff law to encourage private investments in this sector


• The new law will help in gradually deregulating the market

Goal (7.3) double the global rate of improvement in energy efficiency by 2030


# **EDUCATION KPIs**



Goal (4.1) by 2030, ensure that all girls and boys complete free, equitable and quality primary and secondary education leading to relevant and effective learning outcomes


Goal (4.6) by 2030 ensure that all youth and at least x% of adults, both men and women, achieve literacy and numeracy

#### **INNOVATION, KNOWLEDGE & SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH KPIs**



Goal (9.5) enhance scientific research, upgrade the technological capabilities of industrial sectors in all countries, particularly developing countries, including by 2030 encouraging innovation and increasing the number of R&D workers per one million people by x% and public and private R&D spending

#### **HEALTH KPIs**



Goal (3.2) by 2030 end preventable deaths of newborns and under-five children

Goal (3.8) achieve universal health coverage (UHC), including financial risk protection, access to quality essential health care services, and access to safe, effective, quality, and affordable essential medicines and vaccines for all

#### **SOCIAL JUSTICE – CURRENT ACHIEVEMENTS**

- 1. Increasing the Social Security Pension
- 2. Launching a cash-transfer program and increase the number of beneficiaries to 3 million poor families
- 3. Establishing logistics hubs for grain trade and storage to contribute to food security
- 4. Launching a social protection- targeting program using smart cards
- 5. Amending the Social Insurance Law to provide self employed social insurance to farmers with more than one faddan acquisitions
- 6. Extending Medical Insurance to farmers and agriculture workers who do not have access to public health- insurance program
- 7. Implementing Takafol and Karama Programs
- 8. Launching a comprehensive action plan to develop poorest villages

Goal (5c) adopt and strengthen sound policies and enforceable legislation for the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls at all levels



#### **REFORMS OF PLANNING PROCESS: INTEGRATION**

- 1. A unified planning law (national, regional and local planning) (economic, social and spatial).
- 2. A unified database (new base map, unified registry, zip codes, etc...).
- 3. Electronic unified monitoring and evaluation system adopted by all government institutions.
- 4. Result Based Management (RBM).
- 5. Administrative reform: new civil service law.
- 6. Reform of the System of National Accounts (SNA).
- 7. Governance, transparency, and accountability.
