Mr. Tõnis Saar has been working at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Estonia as an Undersecretary General of Administrative Affairs since May 2012. He currently leads the structural changes for all the supportive units towards better value for money. Prior to his appointment with the Foreign Ministry, Mr. Saar served as the Director General of the National Audit Office of Estonia from 2004-2012 where he was responsible for guaranteeing high level administration as well as the quality of the Auditor General's office. He also actively participated to the work of the International Organization of Supreme Audit Institutions, INTOSAI. In 2007 he became Director General of the largest working group of the INTOSAI, the Working Group on Environmental Auditing, WGEA. Mr. Saar is a certified trainer of the INTOSAI Development Initiative (IDI), and has worked on several government auditing and environmental management related trainings and peer-review projects in more than 30 countries worldwide.
