Small Island Developing States (SIDS) have extraordinary marine and terrestrial biodiversity that in many cases is fundamental to their livelihoods and identity. However, their valuable biodiversity and the ecosystem services it provides are at grave risk due to environmental degradation.








STATUS OF REGISTERED PARTNERSHIPS & PROGRESS REPORTS
