Ruth Polachek is a serial entrepreneur, founder and CEO of fintech and edtech startups. Polachek was formerly Head of Citibank's Startup Accelerator, where she mentored and led FinTech startup companies to collaborate with business units and top executives at the global bank, including blockchain startups as early as 2015, introducing these technologies to Citibank's innovation labs and technology teams globally.

Polachek is the Founder and CEO of she codes; is a community of female software engineers, with over 50,000 members and over 500 team members. she codes; holds more than 200 monthly events and runs computer science training programs in 50+ branches across Israel in all the Universities and in major tech hubs and companies, such as Google, IBM, Microsoft and Amazon.



Millie Begovic Ph.D works as a regional innovation advisor for Europe and CIS, supporting UNDP offices in 19 countries and territories to accelerate learning about emerging risks and opportunities stemming from 4th industrial revolution technologies and changing migration patterns (to name a few), and adopt new ways of doing development in order to design new policy responses to deal with these risks. Millie also works with the strategy and planning team at the UNDP's Executive Office supporting the corporate innovation agenda including design of the Accelerator Lab network (setting up 60 Labs in 60 countries), rethinking emerging governance institutions in the age of new technologies (#NextGenGov), and translating principles of platform way of working in international development.



Ayelet Cohen is the Deputy Director of HUJI-Innovate. HUJI Innovate is the Hebrew University's platform to encourage and assist students, faculty and alumni to develop their Innovation and Entrepreneurship capabilities. Prior to this, she served as the director of Jerusalem activities at Start-Up Nation Central, leading a strategic project to develop the Jerusalem tech ecosystem and establish collaboration between multinational corporations, investors, startups, academic institutions and the government. Ayelet also co-founded and managed Google Educators' Groups and Google Teacher Academy in Israel. In addition to her work, she founded and leads several social initiatives such as Dada, 30ish and #53poems.



Guy Franklin is the General Manager of SOSA NYC, an open innovation platform connecting between the largest corporations in the world to technologies and startups. SOSA NYC was recently chosen by the city of NY to run the official Global Cyber Center of the city. In addition, Guy founded "Israeli Mapped in NY" which is an interactive map and platform of all the Israeli startups operating in NY with over 350 of them.
