- Education, language, job skills, training

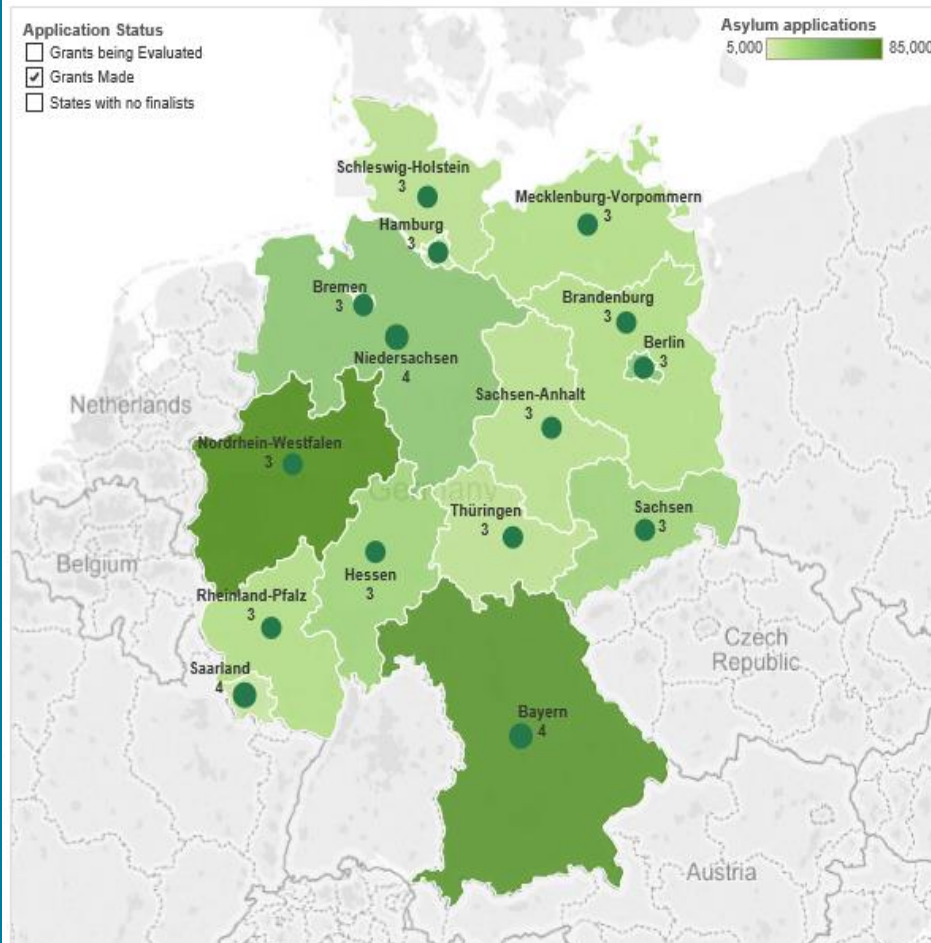


Grants Made By State and Registered Asylum Seekers by State
