About the CSD Partnerships Fair

The Partnerships Fair at the Commission for Sustainable Development (CSD) provides a venue for registered partnerships for sustainable development to showcase progress, launch new partnerships and network with existing and potential partners. The CSD-15 Partnerships Fair will give CSD participants an opportunity to create synergies between partnerships, and learn from each other's experiences.

The Partnerships Fair is an official activity of CSD and will take place at UN Headquarters in New York from 30 April—8 May 2007, with activities running from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm, except on the day of inauguration when the opening session will commence at 3:30pm.

The CSD-15 Partnerships Fair Programme of activities features: “Partnerships in Practice” interactive discussion sessions and Information desks where CSD registered partnerships display and distribute information (all day).

All Partnerships Fair discussion interactive sessions will take place in Conference Room 7, located near the Vienna Café in the first basement of the Conference Building at UNHQ. The Partnerships Fair information desks will be located in the ‘neck area’ (the corridor between the Vienna Café and the elevators in the 1st basement of the Conference Building at UNHQ).

Who can register a partnership with the CSD Secretariat?

While all CSD participants, including representatives of Governments, UN system organizations, other intergovernmental organizations and accredited major groups, are welcome to attend the Partnerships Fair, only those partnerships that are registered with the CSD Secretariat can showcase their initiatives through partnership presentations, information desks and as invited speakers at CSD Interactive Thematic Discussion Sessions.

Partnership registration has numerous benefits. In addition to being able to present at CSD Partnerships Fairs, information on registered partnerships is featured in the online CSD Partnerships Database and website, and this information forms the basis for summary reports prepared for consideration by the CSD, containing synthesized information; statistics on trends; and progress in partnership implementation (see E/CN.17/2006/6 Report of the Secretary-General on Partnerships for Sustainable Development).

Additional CSD Secretariat publications, such as the “Partnership Wire” and the “CSD Partnerships Fair Overview”, are offered on-line to publicize and disseminate to interested audiences around the world, information on the activities and contributions of CSD registered Partnerships in implementing sustainable development goals and objectives.

If you are part of a partnership working in sustainable development areas, you are encouraged to register your initiative with the CSD and take advantage of these services offered by the CSD Secretariat. There is no deadline, no registration fee and registration is an ongoing process.

The CSD Secretariat continues to work on improving its on-line services such as the CSD Partnerships website features and the database functions to facilitate the consideration of partnerships in CSD discussions as well as highlighting the innovative contributions of CSD partnerships through different publications and activities. Addressing Challenges and Lessons Learned from Partnering with the Private Sector

The discussion in this session will focus on practical issues related to private-sector participation in sustainable development partnerships. 43% of the partnerships registered with the CSD Secretariat include private sector partners in their initiatives. The contributions of private sector — not just through financial resources — but specifically through sharing of management expertise, appropriate technologies, building capacity and skills through training activities, have been stressed repeatedly at previous Partnerships Fair discussions and CSD sessions. It is hoped that this discussion session will touch upon on the challenges and lessons learned as well as the key benefits associated with private sector involvement in partnerships working towards sustainable development. Discussants are encouraged to share concrete examples of partnerships working in the areas of energy for sustainable development, industrial development, air pollution/atmosphere and climate change where the private sector has made practical contributions and committed engagements.

SIDS Partnership: Implementation of New Technologies for Sustainable Development

This session will focus on efforts to identify and expand access to new technologies for sustainable development in SIDS. Panelists are encouraged to share concrete examples from their experience in the development and promotion of technologies to harness tidal energy, to enhance aquaculture, and to restore coral reefs for the protection of shorelines, among others. The discussion will aim to identify benefits of particular technologies and practical issues in the development, access, delivery, implementation and long-term use of technologies to contribute to the sustainable development of SIDS as well as the potential for replicability to other countries with coastal territory. The session is also intended to highlight lessons learned from the experience of partnering as a mechanism to identify and promote technological solutions to sustainable development. Partnerships and other collaborative approaches have proven to be essential to deliver and scale up new technologies addressing the specific needs of SIDS.
