












Hurricane Maria SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO




Puerto Rico was existentially stressed long **before Hurricane** Maria struck






Water that Violates the 0 Safe Drinking Water Act



- Locally owned/operated data platform for community development and mitigation planning. Land tenure pathways identified.
- Business continuity planning & back-up energy equipment for micro- and small businesses
- Workforce development & skills certification on recovery projects



RESILIENT DESIGN: To Reduce Risks & Failure

Factors may include:

Natural Environment

- Flooding
- Wind
- Debris
- Landslide
- Earthquake

Other Physical Infrastructure

- Ports, storage & logistics
- Building stock, Industrial facilities
- Water supply
- Transport network
- Telecommunications
- Fuel & materials supply chains & Solid waste management

Social and Economic Considerations

- User skills & experience and willingness to pay
- Public health & safety requirements and community buy-in
- Operations and maintenance staff capacity and availability
- Funding for O+M

RESILIENCE PROJECT

DESIGN TO BUILD RESILIENCE: Reduce Vulnerabilities & Increase Benefits



Direct Benefits may include:

- Enabling economic activity
- Enabling provision of public goods and meeting basic needs
- Enabling provision of social services (education, health, security)
- Enabling connectivity physical and communications

Indirect 'Co-benefits' may include:

- Economic competitiveness
- Household financial well-being
- Improvements in health and well-being
- Improvements in safety and security
- Environmental benefits
- Community amenities
