STI for SDGs Roadmaps

- Providing tools for coherent multi-stakeholders engagement to attain the SDGs
- Establishing evaluation and feedback system with living/ learning process
- Incorporating social, economic and technological action plans
- Taking three-layered structures at national, sub-national and international

Hierarchy of STI for SDGs Roadmaps

International

Global issues/ goals oriented facilitative roadmaps

Incorporating STI elements in ODA and Impact Investment, where possible

e.g. Global Climate Action, ECSAP Regional Roadmap

National

Visualizing concrete action plans aligned to the national priorities and vision with STI as an integral element

e.g. Sweden Fossil Free Initiative, Japan STI for SDGs Roadmapping

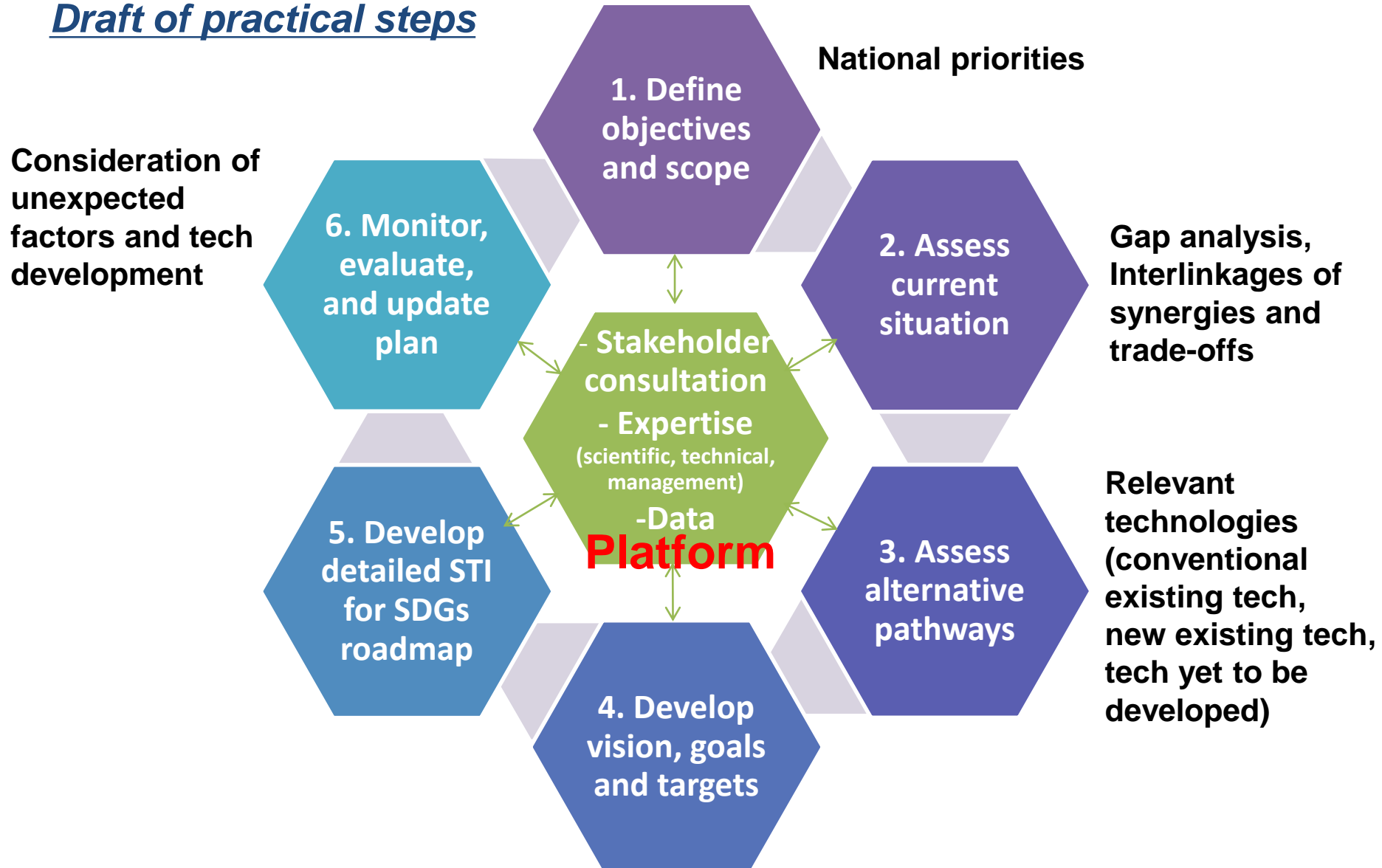
Sub-national

Practical Roadmaps at regional, local, sectorial, institutional levels to draw action plans for attaining specific goals

e.g. Keidanren (Japan), WBCSD's sector roadmaps
