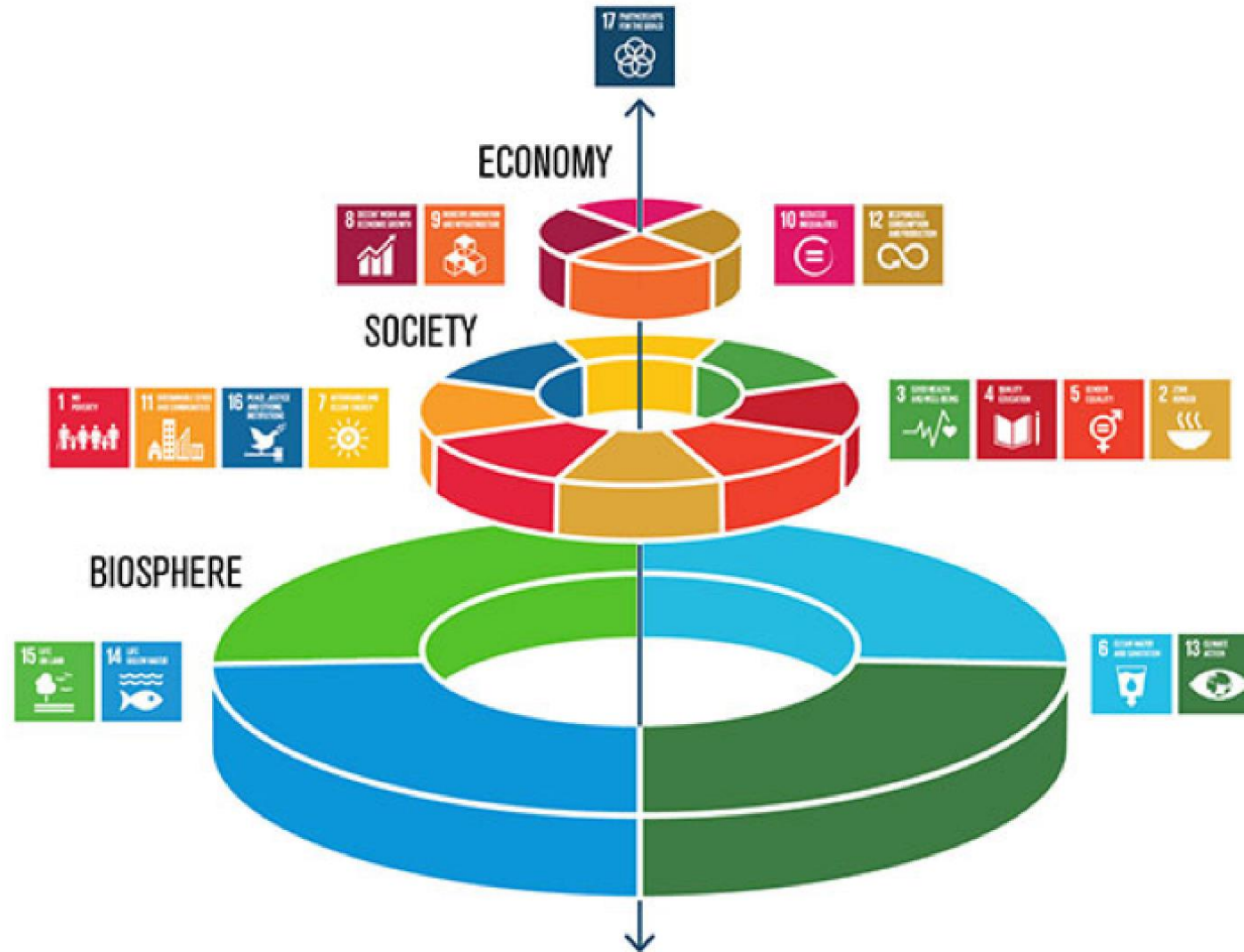


Putting the SDGs in context

Achieving SDGs 1-10 by 2030 will take nearly 3 planets – ONLY ONE PATH LEFT to achieve sustainability by 2050

TRANSFORMATIONAL STRATEGIES

1. Accelerated renewable energy growth:
 - halving emissions every decade from 2030 on
2. Accelerated productivity in food chains:
 - +1% p.a. better productivity
3. New development models in developing countries:
 - copying features of S-Korea, Chinese, Ethiopian successes
4. Active inequality reduction:
 - ensuring 10% richest < 40% of income
5. Investment in education, gender equality, family planning, health stabilizing the world population

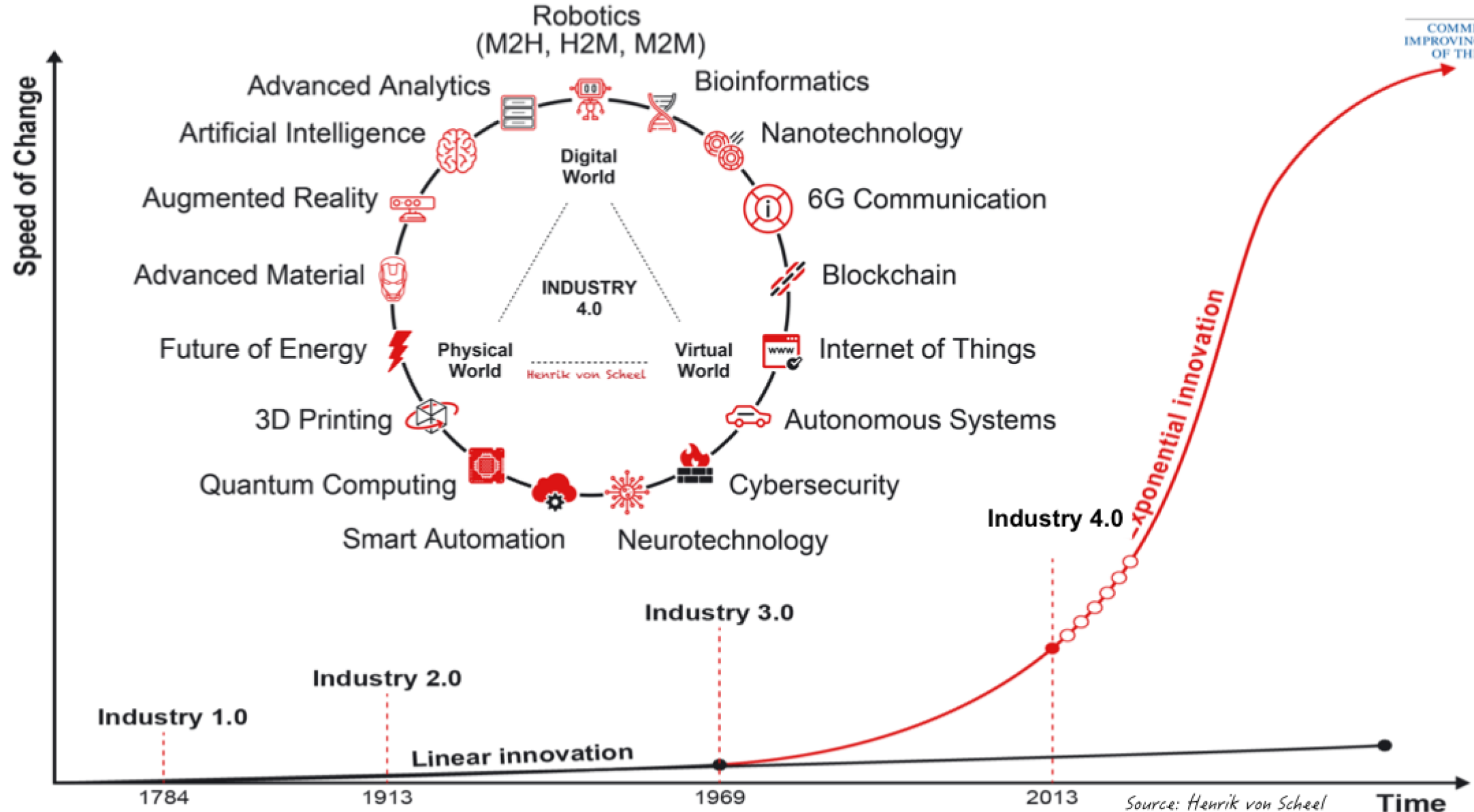

Example: 4IR Technologies From Linear to Exponential



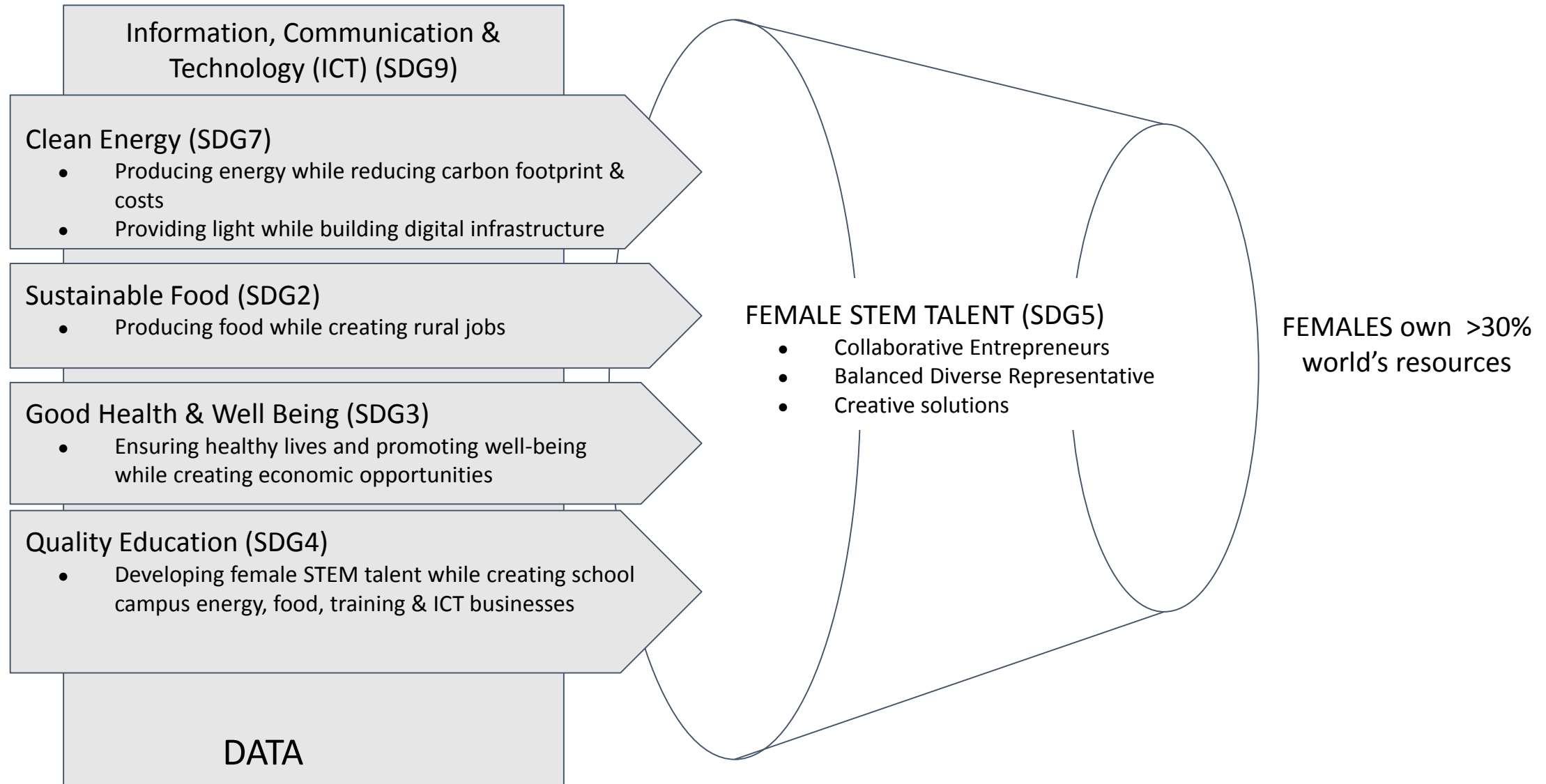
4IR tech in top SDG markets will generate significant wealth

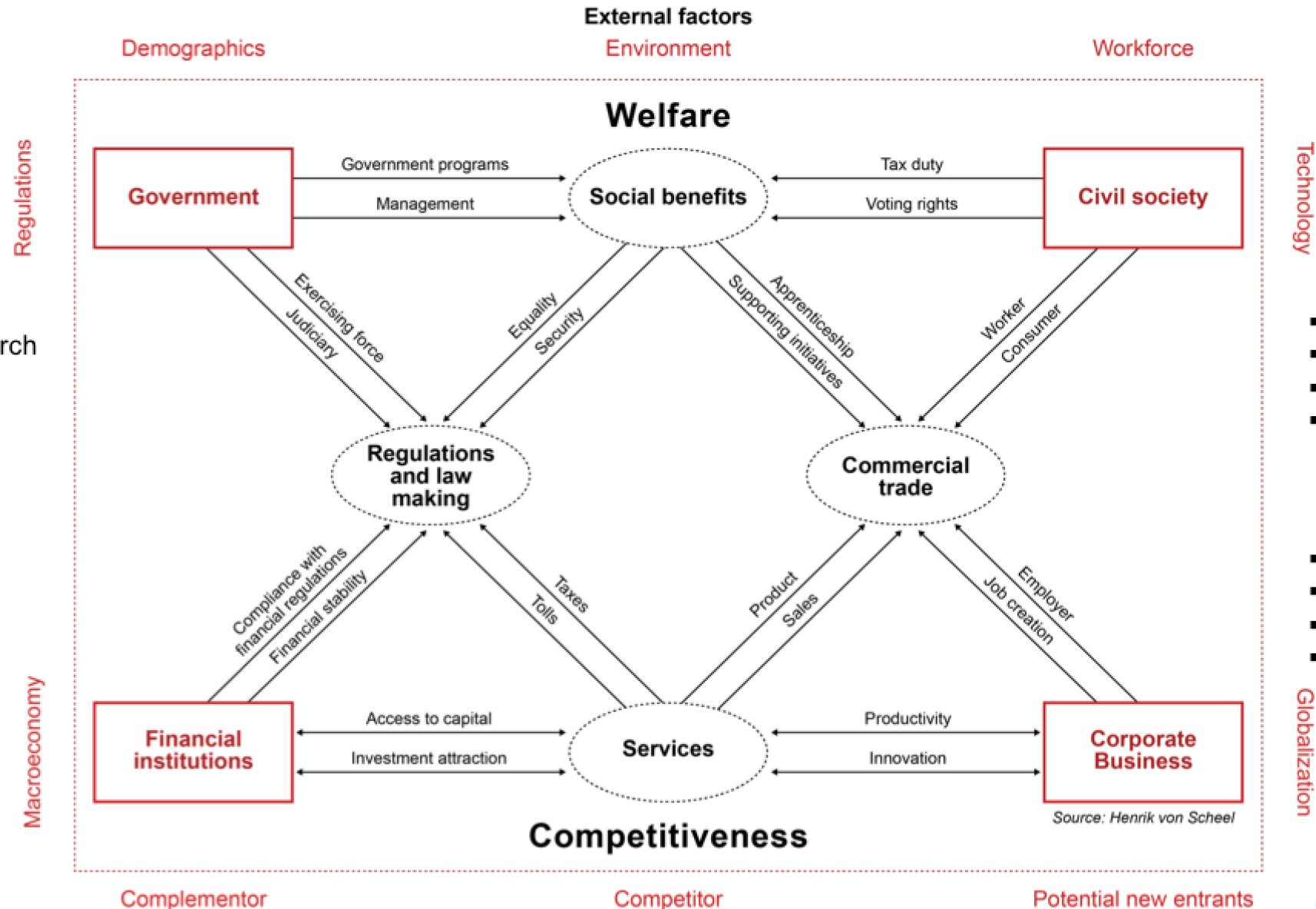

Recommendations for STI Forum

- EVERY STI Forum related event, all panels including side events, should be at least 30% female in speakers/panelists and invitees/audience
- ALL STI Forum inputs & outputs (pre-reading, presentations, outcome documents, etc.) should include a gender lens. Even determining that no gender info is available is helpful. Leverage interest in STI to educate all STI participants (speakers & audience) and observers and raise awareness of gender impacts
- Make “Educating girls” a priority to not only address climate change but also achieve the SDGs
- Show female STI role models and directly connect STI to improving lives to attract more females to STEM degrees and careers
- COLLABORATE & PARTNER, SDG17!!! Promote gender private sector collaboration platforms like ITU’s EQUALS, UN Global Compact Women Empowerment Principles, ITC’s Sourcing from Women Vendors, HeForShe, www.sheheroes.org, etc. Together we can do more!
