(e.g. education, heritage, tourism)



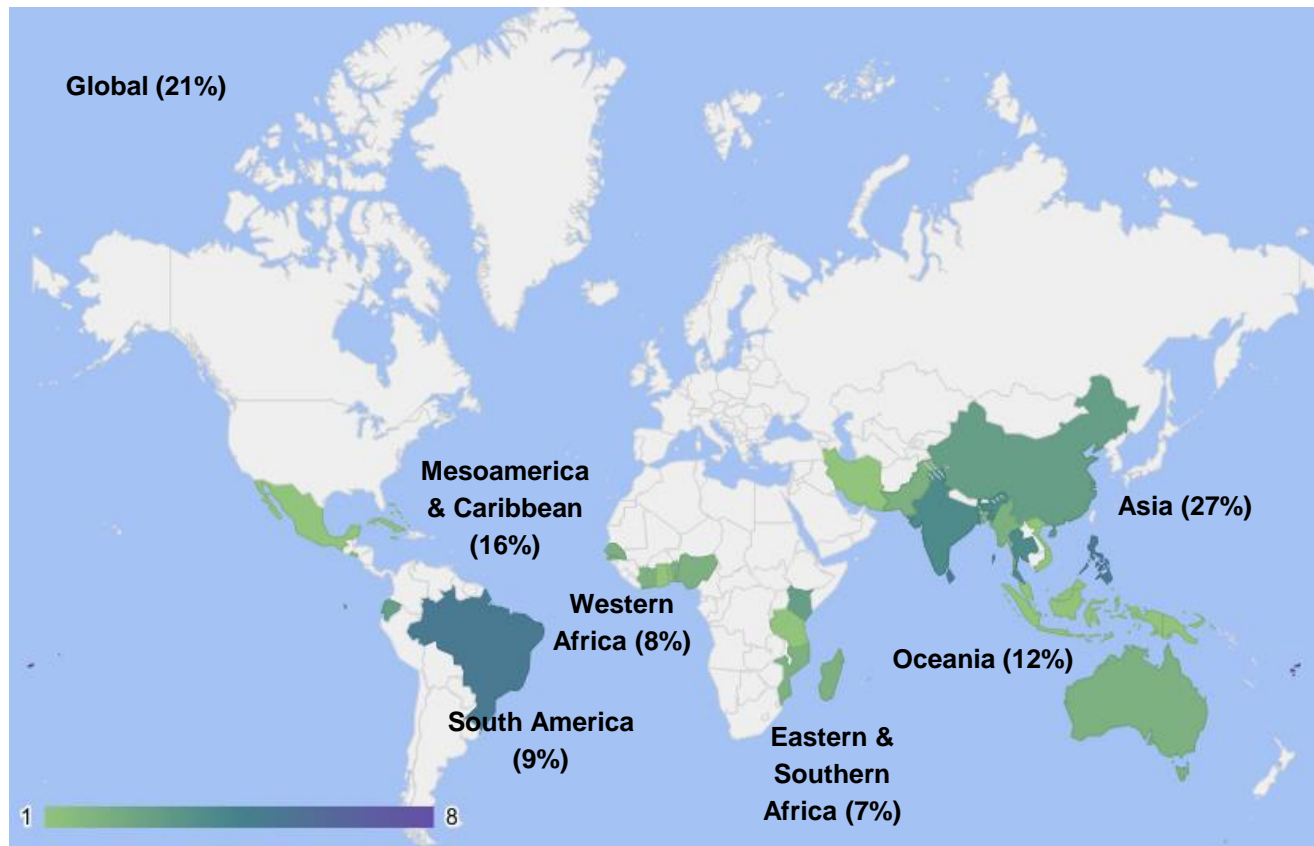

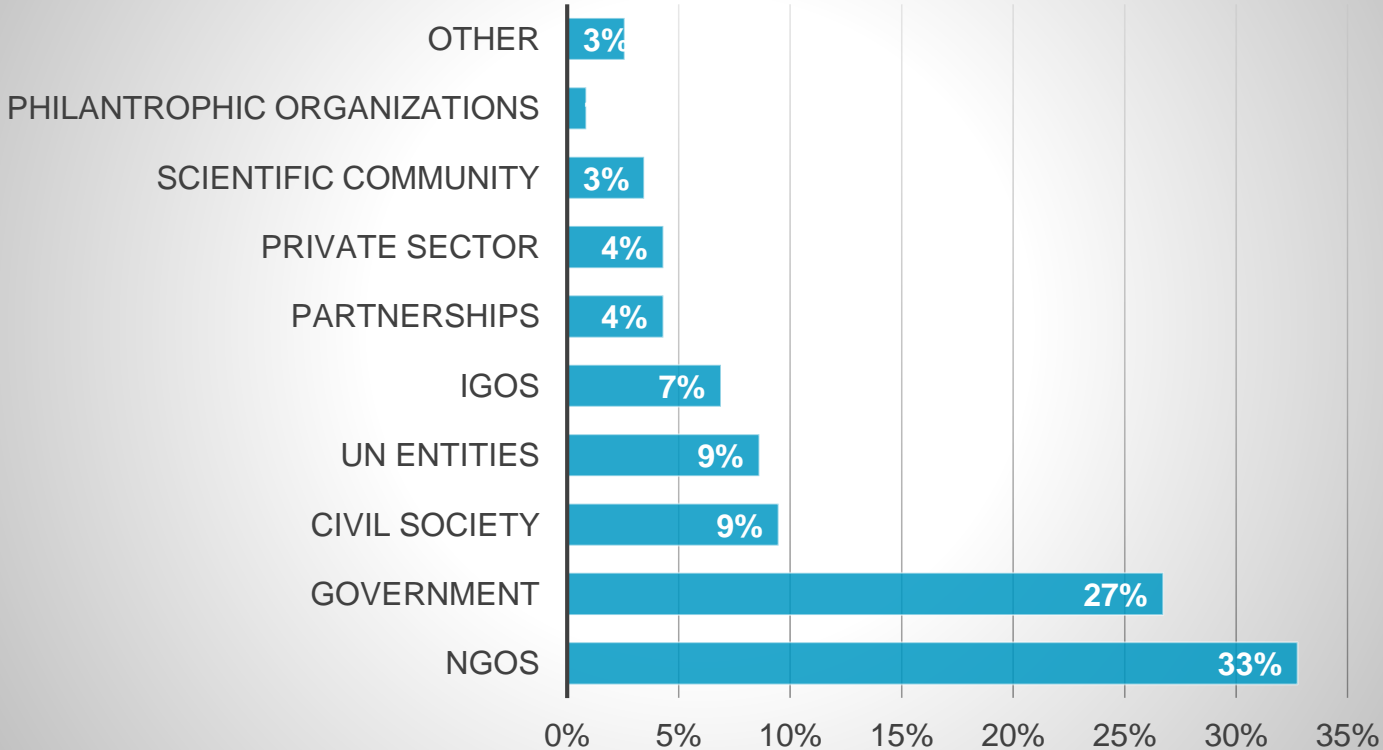

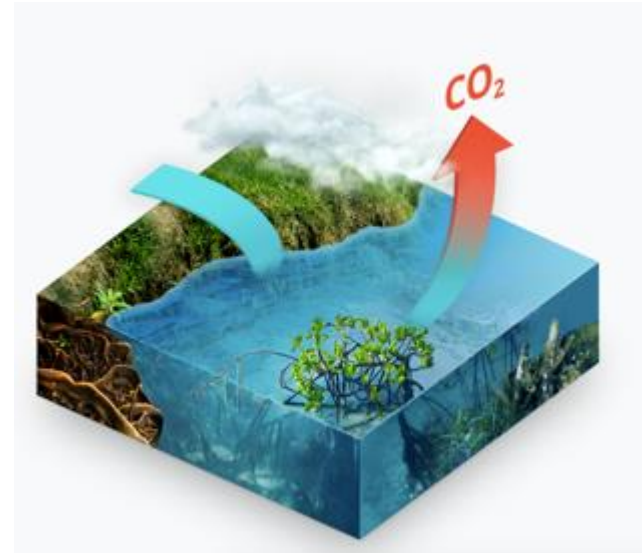

# SDG14 Targets

**72% of VCs**

Contribute to SDG Target 14.2: Sustainable Management and Protection of Marine & Coastal Ecosystems

**46%** : Target 14.5 : Conservation of at least 10% of coastal and marine areas by 2020

**38%** : Target 14.7: Increasing economic benefits to SIDS and least developed countries by 2030

**35%** : Target 14.a: Increasing scientific knowledge & research capacity
