- Roadmaps (engaging with society government and stakeholders – to produce detailed "STI for SDGs" action plans at the local, institutional, national, and global levels that are continually updated and revised)


"STI for SDGs" Strategies for Science Communities (second two or four)

- <u>Systems Analysis</u> (providing scientific input on the global constraints to ensure a stable and resilient earth system -- atmosphere and climate, water and oceans, biodiversity and ecosystems -- to maximize synergies, minimize tradeoffs, and help all countries deliver their share of global responsibilities)
- <u>Disruptive Innovation</u> (advising on how to maximize the opportunities and minimize the threats of rapid technological innovation to enable societies to accelerate progress, negate misuse, and leap over political hurdles)






