

## Sustainability, Safety and Accessibility

- Over half of those living in African cities have no option than to walk to access jobs and services. 84% of roads in LMICs have no pedestrian sidewalk.
- Emissions from road transport have increased by 50% since 1990.
  The 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest growing source of emissions.
- 1.3 million annual road traffic fatalities globally. Majority in low- and middleincome countries.







## Share the Road and the SDG Agenda

- Rio+20 'we recognise the importance of encouraging non-motorized mobility..pedestrian & cycling infrastructures'
- Share the Road in Rio+20 Voluntary Commitments.
- Core part of Sustainable Transport input into Post-2015 process.




