How to **coordinate**/simplify the requirements of international organizations and **UN agencies**? How can we improve policy coherence and coordination amongst international organizations?

Regarding the **accountability framework**: how will we anchor ownership of the implementation and monitoring processes, which data should be collected and where (large, small, aggregate, disaggregate), what are the resources at hand?

Who will have **management responsibility** for the review process and who at the national I level will be responsible for preparing for the HLPF and **coordinating national efforts** to integrate three dimensions of sustainable development?

How can we ensure the **inclusiveness** of a process that is inherently intergovernmental by mandate and how stakeholders can add value through engagement in the process?

GROUP 2

How do we build incentives for all stakeholders to engage in both implementation and review?

What will be the division of labour with the follow-up on SDGs on the one hand and the review of the general SD on the other?

Which **scientific bodies** and actors will we need to engage to develop a methodology for multi-sectoral, cross-cutting review process?

How should the **HLPF participate in the review and monitoring of progress** towards the SDGs and how should the national voluntary reviews be fitted to the programme of the HLPF and how can we make sure that they prove their value to the Member States?

GROUP 3

What should be the role of the Global Sustainable Development report in relation to the HLPF and how best can it define agenda-setting?

How can HLPF agenda setting ensure the balance between predictability and required preparatory time and a reactive agenda that addresses current challenges?

How can we ensure that HLPF reviews build on existing mechanisms and that Member States receive the adequate support needed for them to deliver up-to-date quality report and data?

What should be the role of HLPF in the post-2015 development agenda?
