### **ACTIVITY REPORT**

#### **The Parliamentary Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals (December 2016-September 2017)**

In the period subject to the reporting our Institution has organized the first meeting between OSCE Conference of Parliamentarians and The Parliamentary Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals dedicated to organizational issues and gathering parliamentarians from OSCE (June 2017).

1. An agreement was reached regarding for closer co-operation between the Assembly and the OSCE's executive structures, notably in enhancing the OSCE's efforts to develop a comprehensive and inclusive strategy for the implementation of SDG at organization level and to realize a series of policy brief on the role of SDG in enhancing global efficiency of responses to emerging crisis situations.

2. The Parliamentarian Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals has attended the 9th Plenary Session of the Asian Parliamentary Assembly and created a joint event under the Theme of “Promoting Peace and Sustainable Development in Asia” Siem Reap province, Kingdom of Cambodia.

The vent was held under the theme of “Promoting Peace and Sustainable Development in Asia” with the participation of the delegations from 23 APA member countries in order to present the importance of the Sustainable Development Goals Agenda 2030 and to encourage the ASEAN member countries to register to the PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS initiative.

3. The new logo of The Parliamentarian Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals was unveiled on August 17, 2017 on the occasion of the acceptance of the MP number 250.

The international Campaign for the implementation of 2030 Agenda of United Nations, known worldwide as SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS AGENDA, in the work of parliaments across the world has reached a first milestone, only after a year of existence, with the support of 250 parliamentarians from 20 national parliaments.

Now with this threshold passed, the Parliamentary Assembly for SDG`s, is now endorsed across party lines, ideologies and national agenda`s by more than 250 current members of parliament from over 20 countries.

Between 16/17 September 2017 The Parliamentarian Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals has reached in Caracas the representatives of Latin American parliaments in the hope of reaching an agreement for Sustainable Development Goals activity and implementation in Latin America Parliament`s Activity.

5. On July 14, 2017, The Parliamentarian Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals has hosted the presentation and public signature of the United Nations Open Letter to Academic Institutions: Educate Future Managers and Leaders on Business and Human Rights.

6. The Parliamentarian Assembly for Implementation of Sustainable Development Goals has made public the United Nations General Assembly President letter calling on world leaders support for the global implementation of Sustainable Development Goals.

President of United Nations General Assembly, Ambassador Peter Thomson had addressed a letter to the head of states and global leaders urging a better knowledge and acceptance of Sustainable Development Goals.

The letter addressed to 190 world leader`s and global influencer`s calls for world level re-enforced cooperation agreement to the implementation of SDG and had come as a result of a general appeal from UN General Assembly President.

I must reiterate our support and warm appreciation for your efforts on behalf of Sustainable Development Goals Initiative and we are remaining true to our dedication and commitment in a common vision for a better world.
