- Lack of awareness on chemical management issues
- Inadequate political commitment
- Lack of information on chemicals
- Lack of technical capacity and expertise
- Lack of funding
- Varieties of existing conventions, activities, regulations
- Problems with outreach to developing countries
- One institution can not singly achieve the goal

## Identify the strategies how to address these challenges

- Improve the availability of reliable information on chemicals;
- o Increase monitoring efforts and research on existing and emerging issues
- o Increase awareness on chemical management issues;
- Assess and quantify the benefits of sound management of chemicals long perspective
- Communicate the positive effects of chemicals to all stakeholders highlightinghow effective chemicals management can support meeting MDGs, e.g. energy and climate goals, fight world hunger / prevent children's death
- Integrate chemicals management into national development programmes;
- o Promote knowledge and skills transfer in line with countries' needs;
- o Establish integrated /harmonized approaches to chemicals management
