## Korea Electric Power Corporation (KEPCO)

- **Location** 36. Munnyeon-ro, Jeju-si, Jeju-do

- **About** KEPCO, incorporated on July 1, 1961, is an integrated electric utility company engaged in the transmission and distribution of electricity in Korea. The Company's segments include transmission and distribution, nuclear power generation and thermal power generation and all others. KEPCO was founded with the objective to facilitate the development of electric power supply in Korea, meet the country's power supply and demands needs, and contribute to the national economy in accordance with the Korea Electric Power Corporation Act. KEPCO is classified as a market-oriented public corporation under the Act on the Management of Public Institutions.

## Tamra Offshore Wind Power (탐라해상풍력발전(주))

- **Location** 19 Dumo 11-gil, Hangeang-myeon, Cheju, Jeju-do  
63002 제주특별자치도 제주시 한경면 두모 11 길 19(두모리 2579-1)
- **About** Tamra Offshore Wind Power is the first of its kind built in Korea. Upon its completion in September 2017, the plant has been generating renewable energy for Jeju Island, creating jobs for locals and contributing in export of know-how about renewable energy. With 10 wind turbines of 30MW Capacity, the plant generates 85,000MWh a year. This has an effect of reducing 40,000 tons of CO2 emission a year.

## Hallim Park (한림공원)

- **Location** 300, Hallim-ro, Hallim-eup, Jeju-si, Jeju-do  
제주특별자치도 제주시 한림읍 한림로 300 (한림읍)
- **About** Hallim Park is one of the most popular tourist spots on Jeju Island, located about 33km west of Jeju City and Mt. Hallasan along the beach in Hallim-eup. It faces the pleasant scenery of Biyangdo Island, Hyeopjae Beach and Geumneung Beach. The park was established on barren land in Hyeopjaeri, Hallimeup, then covered with tons of earth and the planting of assorted subtropical plants began in early 1971. It has a variety of gardens that can be enjoyed in any season. Visitors can enjoy checking out Palm Tree Road, Jeju Stone and Bonsai Garden, Water Garden, Subtropical Botanic Garden and much more. The most famous tourist sites in Hallim Park are Hyeopjaegul and Ssangyonggul Caves, known to be the only two-dimensional caves in the world.
- **Available Facilities** Palm tree road, subtropical botanical garden, Hyeopjae-Ssangyong Cave (National Monument No. 236), Jejuseok-Bunjaewon, Jaeam Folk Village, safari bird garden, pond garden, restaurants, resting area, souvenir shop, storage room, etc
