"Form follows function"

1992 Rio Summit (a milestone for humanity) outcomes: <u>Agenda 21</u>, <u>CSD</u>
Sustainable Development = Economic, Social and **Environment**

2000 – Millennium Summit: MDGs

2012 Rio+20 Conference –2 themes (GESDPE & IFSD) outcomes TFWW:

Institutional framework on Sustainable Development in Romania


- The Inter-ministerial Committee for the Coordination of the Integration of Environmental Protection into Sectoral Policies and Strategies at the National Level, representing the main decisionmaking body for sustainable development in Romania – Lead by Vice prime Minister, Minister of Environment (2001 EU Aquis /2011 SD)
- The Sub-commission for Sustainable Development in the Parliament of Romania (2015)
- The Department for Sustainable Development under the Secretariat General of the Government, lead by a State Counsellor/ main responsibility on the implementation of 2030 Agenda at national level. (2017)


